

Minutes of the July 09, 2024

17:30 Call to order

Board Members Present: Chair Javier Saunders, Sam Laub, Jacquelin Greulich, Andrew Hollingworth.
Appointed Community Members Present: Paul Grimes. Also Present was PCB Member Angela Vedder.

B. Review and Approval of Minutes

The Committee approved the June 2024, Committee Meeting Minutes. Motion by Sam and second by Andrew H. Minutes were unanimously approved 5-0.

C. Non-agenda public comments;

Paul G – stated that Max Apocado has resigned from the Committee as an appointed Community.

Andrew H. provided an update on the H Barracks and Kettner/Vine St. Homeless Shelter. Andrew stated the H Barracks will be before the Costal Commission for approval and he will be part of the presentation team.

Javier S-announced the next meeting for the Midway Rising Project will be held on August 8, in Rancho Bernardo.

D.a. Receive input on potential CIP priorities for FY 25-26 Budget.

The committee reviewed the PCPC CIP recommendations for FY 24-25 Budget Year and agreed to delete the Traffic Calming Measures at Nimitz & Evergreen St. and Roundabout, Review of Nimitz & Rosecrans Intersection Traffic Review, and Froude and Voltaire Flashing Beacons (completed). The committee also agreed to include a new project, Sidewalk Improvements on Lomaland Drive between PLN University to Catalina Blvd. Javier S. made a motion to delete the committee recommended projects and add the Sidewalk Improvements from PLNU to Cataline Blvd. The motion was seconded by Andrew H. The CIP priorities were unanimously approved by the committee (5-0).

D.b. Discuss and review Sunset Cliffs Coastal Resilience Master Plan.

Several committee members stated the Public Hearing by the Planning Committee in Ocean Beach very well attended that committee attendance exceed the capacity of the room and many community members were unable to voice their views and opinion on the proposed Plan. Due to the importance of this project to the community, the committee made a motion **to Authorize the PCPB to Request a Formal presentation to the PCPB and Community on the Sunset Cliffs Blvd. Coastal Resilience Program and solicit community input.** The motion was approved 5-0.

D.c. Update on Blueprint SD

The council will consider the adoption of **Blueprint SD** on July 23, 2024. The Board authorized Javier S. and Andrew H. to speak in opposition. Javier is looking for Board and community members to concede time. Angela V. and Jacquelin G. stated they may be available.
