2. Discussion on E-Bikes in the area

Submit a letter for E-Bike Education and Accountability Measures. The letter request for the Implementation of AB2234 E-Bike Regulations for the City of San Diego. Mandy Havlik drafted and circulated a letter to the Traffic and Transportation subcommittee for review and approval. All approve 5-0.

Approved letter sent to the PCPB for approval at the November 21st board meeting.

3. Discuss on Cannon St turning onto Evergreen St.

Narrow portion of the street is yellow striped making it unsafe for bikers/pedestrians and there has been many vehicle accidents.

Research items:

1. Are the double yellow lines in the correct position?
2. Consider striping to yellow diagonal line for turning onto Evergreen. (southbound).
3. Consider vehicles proceeding on Cannon street, going straight.

Motion to approve, to take action with the city. Mandy Havlik makes the first motion, Robert Jackson seconds the motion, all approve 5-0.

4. Discussion on installation of two road humps on Evergreen St, one between Jarvis St and Ingelow St, and another one between Ingelow St and Hugo St.
